German Starboard ProKids contest

The German shooting star Max Droege wins the German Starboard ProKids contest

The Surf-Festival on the German island Fehmarn is well known by the windsurfers as a place to meet and get in contact with stars from the whole world. Thanks to the visit of the Starboard teamrider Kiri Thode, the people got to know about the high standard in youth windsurfing. There have never been so many kids on the water, who practiced new freestyle moves.

Another reason for coming was the chance to win a ticket to the Caribbean island Bonaire! Starboard and the youth project KeikiSurfer have organized the German Starboard Pro Kids Freestyle Trophy with the aim to get the best youth windsurfers onto the water and show in heats of 10 minutes, what they are able to perform.

The Friday should become the most important day of the kids' lives! Planning conditions and 12 kids with the aim to win a ticket and fly to Bonaire! The future freestyle stars went onto the water in groups of four people. During the 3 pre-selective runs, the best freestyler of each group was found. The small kids could show their ability of soft moving freestyle. And the older ones (up to 17 years) performed a lot of new-school tricks.

The final run was more than exciting! Flakas, Spock 540s and many no-wind tricks were performed. The jump of the day was shown by Max, who landed his speedloop directly at the beach. He also showed the best mixture of moves and could convince the judges Klaas Voget, Brian Talma und Andy Wirtz. The prize giving took place on the large stage of the Surf-Festival. More than 300 people celebrated the success of the KeikiSurfer teamrider Max Droege. Also 2nd Adrian Benholz, and 3rd Leon Jamaer along with KeikiSurfer teamrider Marc Hoefkens were happy about having reached these high positions in the competition.

Afterwards, all kids at the beach were invited by the project KeikiSurfer to get onto the water for learning new freestyle moves. Sebastian Ronneberger was accompanied by Kiri Thode and Taty Frans, who gave a lot of impressions for learning new tricks.

We are looking forward to the Youth Freestyle Worldchampionships at Bonaire!
